

**Witness submission: Dara Singh  
Nanavati Commission**

I am shown my affidavit filed before this Commission. In addition to what I have stated in my affidavit I state that on 31<sup>st</sup> October 1984 about 25 persons who were not from our locality had come near our house. I had seen that they were carrying a list showing the houses in which Sikhs were staying. I had seen them putting marks on the houses of Sikhs, but I had not understood the significance of it.

Cross examination by Shri S.S. Gandhi, Senior Advocate on behalf of Delhi Police.

The persons who had come near our house on 31<sup>st</sup> October 1984 were in the age group of 30 to 35. They all appeared to be belonging to one place. They were outsiders. I have not complained any time before I filed an affidavit before this Commission that I had gone to thana, and the police had refused to take down my complaint.
